

Subject: PG&E Comments on Title 20 15-Day Language for Battery Charger Systems Test Procedure ; 2008 Appliance Efficiency Rulemaking, Phase I, Part B Docket Number 08-AAER-1B

Dear Ms. Pfannenstiel and Mr. Rosenfeld:

Pacific Gas and Electric (PG&E) recommends that the CEC adopt the Test Procedure for Battery Charger Systems as described in the current 15-day language (docket number 08-AAER-1B). PG&E and its consultant Ecos Consulting, having closely reviewed the *Energy Efficiency Battery Charger System Test Procedure Version 2.2*, recommend the following typo/clarifying corrections be made to the test procedure under the administrative provisions allowed by the Commission during the 15-day language period for rulemaking.

The following typo/clarifying corrections are recommended:

- 1. Page 26, Part 2 Section II.C, 4th and 5th line in first paragraph the phrase "by driving or other means of discharge" should be deleted. The new sentence should read: "The battery shall be depleted to roughly 80% depth of discharge..."
- 2. Page 26, Part 2 Section II.C, 6th line in first paragraph the word "three" should be replaced with "two". The new sentence should read: "Do this two times."
- 3. Page 28, Part 2 Section III.A 1, items 1, 2, 3 should be moved to page 29, Part 2 Section III.A 2, in between items 23 and 24, and the word "Starting" should be replaced with "End" in item 1.
- 4. Page 32, Part 2 Section III.C, item 5, "Note:" should be deleted.
