RE: Request for Delay in Responding to the CEC's 2009 IEPR Data Request on Demand, Price and Resources

Dear Ms. *Melissa* Jones,

As I mentioned to you last week, PG&E would like to request a one-month delay in the due date for our complete response to the CEC's 2009 IEPR data request for demand, price and supply data, from February 13 to March 13. Our request is motivated by two realities. First, the energy efficiency projections requested are, in part, still under development. We will be filing our 2009-2011 programs with the CPUC on February 17<sup>th</sup>, and would like our data response to your agency to be consistent with that filing. Second, we believe we will need a significant amount of staff time, on the order of two to three weeks, to develop the requested total and customer-group-specific revenue requirement forecasts. This work cannot be started until the demand, supply, and generic resource forecasts are complete

Please don't hesitate to call me at the above number if you have any questions or concerns. I've been in touch separately with a number of your staff involved with the data request to let them know of our requested delay.
