

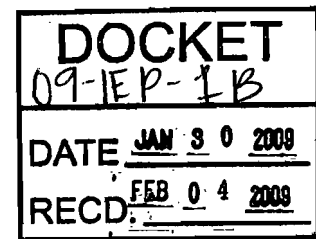

RE: PG&E's request for extension to submit 2009 IEPR electricity data

Dear Ms. Treleven,

This letter responds to your January 21, 2009, written request to extend the filing deadline for certain IEPR electricity data. Your request includes all required data on historical and forecast data on electricity demand, retail prices, and resource plans. According to forms and instructions adopted by the Energy Commission on December 17, 2008, this information is to be submitted by February 13, 2009, for our assessment work as part of the 2009 *Integrated Energy Policy Report*. PG&E is requesting an extension of this filing deadline to March 13, 2009.

Based on the information provided in your letter, I find that good cause exists for an extension and that the required data and narrative information is likely to be submitted by the extended due date of March 13, 2009.

If there are similar extension requests in the future, please include a declaration executed under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of California declaring the relevant facts and determinations as described in Section 1342(c) of the California Code of Regulations, Title 20, Division 2, Article 2. As a courtesy to PG&E, and as a result of a long history of compliance and participation in our proceedings, I waive the requirement of the formal declaration in this instance.

We look forward to the energy efficiency projections now under development for 2009-2011 programs, and we appreciate that staff time will be required to integrate those projections with the demand forecast, revenue requirement forecast, and supply resource plans.
