The attached Excel file was submitted today by Valley Electric Association headquartered in Pahrump, Nevada. Valley Electric is a rural electric cooperative that serves load in Nevada and California. The vast majority of this load is in Nevada. The attached historical and forecast data refers only to load in California, most of which is irrigation load.

Good Morning Jim,

I have attached the requested documents showing our anticipated California loads for 2010. The numbers used for 2010 are basically the same as the ones forecasted for 2009 as our loads are relatively flat and we don't see any growth occurring in California on our small system.

The resources used to cover the load are broken into two groups. The first is the portion of our Lower Colorado River Hydro resources and capacity that will be used to cover the hourly loads and the second is the portion of our three year contract with Constellation that will be used to cover these loads.

I am sending this a couple of days before the due date with hopes you will have a few minutes to scan through the pages and see if I interrupted the instructions. Another word on the Hydro and why I listed it under contracts is because we don't own the resource although we do put in day ahead hourly schedules.
