

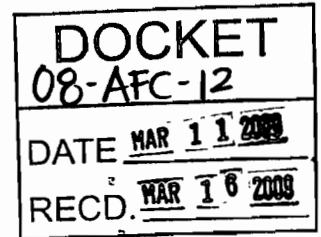

I. INTRODUCTION

On November 26, 2008, San Joaquin Solar 1, LLC, and San Joaquin Solar 2, LLC jointly submitted an Application for Certification for the San Joaquin Solar 1 & 2 hybrid solar and biomass power project. The proposed 106.8-megawatt hybrid power project will be located 6 miles east of the City of Coalinga, Fresno County.

II. SUMMARY OF HEARING


At a regularly scheduled business meeting on March 11, 2009, the Commission accepted the AFC as complete and appointed a Committee to preside over the San Joaquin Solar 1 & 2 project Application for Certification proceedings pursuant to Public Resources Code section 25211 and Title 20, California Code of Regulations, section 1204.

III. ORDER

Having been accepted as complete on March 11, 2009, under Public Resources Code section 25522, the Application for Certification for the San Joaquin Solar 1 & 2 project is deemed filed as of that date. The statutory timeline for a final decision under Public Resources Code section 25540.6 shall begin as of March 11, 2009, the filing date. The Commission hereby appoints **Julia A. Levin** as Presiding Member and **James D. Boyd** as Associate Member to serve as a Committee to preside over the San Joaquin Solar 1, LLC, and San Joaquin Solar 2, LLC, jointly filed Application for Certification proceedings.
