This CD contains one or more recordings (on-screen activity with the conference call) of the WebEx session(s).

To view the WebEx recordings:

- 1) Double-click on a recorded file.
- 2) If it does not start playing because you do not have the WebEx Player installed on your computer:
 - a) You can install the free Player by double-clicking on the "Downloads.html" file in the WebEx Player folder on this CD.
 - b) Scroll down to the bottom of the page to the "WebEx Player" section and click on the "Download" button for your type of computer (Windows or Mac).
 - c) In the dialogue box that appears, click on the appropriate button to have it install the WebEx player software (your computer might display "Open" or "Run" or "Install"). Respond to the prompts as needed. It will probably place an icon for the Player on your computer's desktop.
 - d) Open the WebEx Player software. Then select File...Open... and select the recorded meeting file.
- 3) Once the recording is playing, you can control playback with the floating panel. It lets you start, pause, stop, fast forward, as well as control the volume and move to different points in the recording.
