Please docket this transmittal email from the City and County of San Francisco (CCSF). This transmittal includes new and complete S-1 and S-2 supply forms.

Also included is an S-3 supply form reporting CCSF hourly loads in 2008 at four different take-out points from the high voltage grid.

CCSF supplies energy to serve municipal demand and retail deliveries in CAISO with takeout points in the City of San Francisco (using the PG&E distribution system) and at SFO Airport (using CCSF distribution wires). CCSF also sells wholesale energy to Modesto Irrigation District (MID) and to Turlock Irrigation District (TID) with a take-out point on CCSF's high voltage transmission from Hetch Hetchy generating resources (transmission that is not part of the CAISO controlled grid).

At the Norris takeout in Stanislaus County, CCSF also delivers a small amount of energy to a commercial facility in Riverbank that was munitions armory during World War II.

In terms of end-use demand, CCSF is a "small" load-serving entity (LSE) with peak demand in 2007 of 182 MW. When non-firm energy sales to MID and TID are included, this LSE had an hourly peak load in 2007 of 377.6 MW. The peak load served in a single balancing authority area did not exceed 200 MW in 2007 or 2008.
