Please note, that Mr. Strobridge comments in regards to Constitutional Rights, shall be taken very seriously.

We noticed, that Mr. Strobridge resides in Santa Margarita, California and the City is surrounded by a very sensitive habitat, as well as within a probable Wildlife Corridor and as alleged herein, could be blocking movement, in each direction, of endangered and sensitive species. (Attached hereto is an Aerial of Santa Margarita and incorporated herein for reference).

Therefore, Mr. Strobridge concerns about Wildlife Corridor, alleged to be within the proximity of the privately owned land by Ausra, could be as a direct result thereof where Mr. Strobridge resides.

We believe, that is more than appropriate for the Commission to seek from the ALJ a mandate to all participants in addressing the actual siting location therein all documents of this AFC, construed as a legal mandate.
