Subject: **SAN JOAQUIN SOLAR 1 & 2 HYBRID PROJECT (08-AFC-12) STATUS REPORT 1**

Staff submits the following Status Report for the proposed San Joaquin Solar 1 & 2 Hybrid Project (SJS), pursuant to the Committee Scheduling Order dated May 7, 2009.

Current Issues and Activities for Resolution

Staff has been working through the discovery and analysis phase of the proposed SJS project Application for Certification (AFC). Staff has issued one set of data requests and has received two partial sets of data responses (28 out of 148 requests) on May 20, 2009; and on June 1, 2009, responses to an additional 62 data requests were received.

The applicant has requested an extension of time (to July 15, 2009) for responding to an additional **112** Data Requests and has objected to eight data requests as cited below:

- Mobile source emissions associated with the transportation of biomass within the San Joaquin Valley. (Air Quality DR #'s 8-13, and 24)
- Preparation of a detailed Phase 1 Environmental Site Assessment on approximately 25 different sites along the alternative 6-mile route of the proposed 230 kV transmission line. (Waste Management DR #'s 143-144).

Staff is reviewing the objections and is working towards clarification of the requests or resolution of the objections. Staff and the applicant are discussing the potential for a Data Request workshop, to be held near the end of June, to provide clarification of those data requests for which the applicant has requested additional time, and discussion of the data requests to which the applicant has objected.

Schedule

The scheduled date for the data response and issue resolution workshop will be delayed due to the additional time required for the applicant to complete their data responses. The applicant indicated that the remaining data responses would be provided by July 15, 2009.

Given this circumstance, staff anticipates the publication of the PSA will occur no sooner than the original schedule of August 27, 2009, reflecting the request for additional time to provide the responses to staff data requests. Staff is now anticipating the following departure from the initial Committee Scheduling Order of May 7, 2009.
