No Use or Storage of Hydrogen**


Dear Mr. Caswell:

On April 20, 2009, La Paloma Generating Company, LLC (LPGC), received your letter dated April 10, 2009 pertaining to hazardous materials - use and storage of hydrogen at the La Paloma Generating Plant. Prior to that date Mary Dyas, CEC Compliance Project Manager, and Zenis Walley had discussed the fact that LPGC neither uses or stores hydrogen at the La Paloma Generating Plant, which is reflected in the Chemical Inventory Business Plan submitted annually to the local CUPA. This was documented in an email to the CEC dated April 8, 2009.

Based on an April 28 email correspondence with Ms. Dyas, we understood that the CEC would advise LPGC on whether or not it needed to respond to the CEC April 10 letter. On June 8, Ms. Dyas advised that a formal letter response was indeed necessary. Therefore, for the record and in response to the April 10 CEC letter, LPGC confirms that hydrogen is not used or stored at the La Paloma Generating Plant.
