RE: Docket No. 07-AFC-4: Urge CEC DENIAL of Chula Vista Energy Upgrade Project

Dear Chair Douglas and Commissioners:

I am writing today to urge you to deny the application of the Chula Vista Energy Upgrade Project. I believe Commissioner Boyd made the correct decision in his recommendation that the permit be denied because of the conflict with the Chula Vista General Plan. All testimony from everyone who was directly involved in the drafting and finalization of that General Plan has confirmed that their intention, and that of the Chula Vista City Council, was to prohibit all power plants from being located less than 1000 feet from residential land uses. It is very clear that the proposed location of the MMC upgrade is incompatible with Chula Vista's general plan. There are many other suitable locations within Chula Vista or the greater south bay area where a peaker plant could be sited appropriately; in addition, of course, there are many other options for generation of energy and reduction of the peak load which could eliminate the need for any new peakers in our region. Thank you for consideration of my comments.
