The San Joaquin Valley Unified Air Pollution Control District (District) has reviewed the Final Staff Assessment for the proposed Avenal Energy Project (08-AFC-1). approval of the project would allow the operation of a 600-megawatt combined cycle electric power plant. The District offers the following comments:

- 1. Chapter 4.1 Air Quality includes discussions on the regulatory environment, existing air quality conditions; and project related emissions. Table 8 (page 4:1-15) identifies project related construction emissions as exceeding the District's 10 ton per year threshold of significance for NOx. The Final Staff Assessment concludes that with mitigation, construction emissions would be less than significant. The conclusion appears predicated on the assumption that compliance with mitigation measure AQ-SC5, which requires the use of engines meeting Tier 2 requirements, when possible, on all equipment greater than 100 horsepower will reduce construction emissions to a level of less than significant. To support the conclusion, the District recommends that Table 8 be amended to include estimates of both unmitigated and mitigated emissions. If the analysis demonstrates that project construction related impacts on air quality would exceed District thresholds, the District recommends that the CEC consider imposing additional mitigation measures.
- 2. References to Avenal Power 2008b and AFC Appendix 6.2 are made throughout the discussions on air quality (Chapter 4.1) and public health (Chapter 4.7). However, the reference material is not included as part of the final assessment provided to the District for review....To ensure full disclosure to the public, the District recommends that all reference material be included as appendices with the document.
