Purpose

The purpose of this workshop is to discuss current progress and issues in the above technical areas and to provide the parties and members of the public with an opportunity to understand the current status of the proposed project. The draft agenda is as follows:

- 1. Recent updates to the proposed project, including schedule
- 2. Discussion of Alternatives currently being evaluated for consideration by BLM and staff
- 3. Biological Resource issues including the following:
 - a. Rare plant avoidance and mitigation
 - b. Desert Tortoise relocation/translocation areas and requirements
 - c. Desert Tortoise habitat compensation including integration of BLM, CDFG and Energy Commission requirements
 - d. Incidental Take Permit requirements
 - e. Streambed Alteration Agreement requirements
 - f. Closure, Revegetation and Rehabilitation Plan
- 4. Soil and Water Resources issues including the following:
 - a. Stormwater impacts to heliostats/surrounding environment and approaches to minimize effects
 - b. Anticipated damage to heliostats in storm events

- c. Stormwater volume and discharge rates for existing and developed conditions
- d. Lahontan RWQCB permit requirements

The topic areas are currently being analyzed by BLM and staff, and the results of the workshop discussions will be reflected in the Final Staff Assessment/Draft Environmental Impact Statement. The Administrative Draft of this document is scheduled to be completed in late August.

Background

On August 30, 2007, Solar Partners, LLC filed an Application for Certification (AFC) with the Energy Commission to develop a 400-megawatt solar thermal power plant on public lands managed by the BLM. Review of this proposed project is currently in the analysis phase of a joint state and federal agency environmental and engineering review proceeding.


