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**FOURTH STATUS REPORT OF
MIRANT WILLOW PASS, LLC**

In accordance with the Committee Scheduling Order dated December 31, 2008, Mirant Willow Pass, LLC (“Mirant Willow Pass”) submits its fourth status report in this proceeding. On June 30, 2008, Mirant Willow Pass submitted an Application for Certification (“AFC”) for the Willow Pass Generating Station (“WPGS”), a 550 megawatt, natural gas-fired electricity generating facility to be located at a site within the existing site of the Pittsburg Power Plant in Pittsburg, California. The AFC was determined to be data adequate on October 8, 2008.

Staff issued a second set of Data Requests (58 through 74) on April 28, 2009, addressing Biological Resources, Socioeconomics, Soil and Water Resources, Transmission System Engineering, and Waste Management. Mirant Willow Pass has submitted responses to all Data Requests in this second set, except for Waste Management Data Requests 73 through 75, which ask for a workplan, soil vapor sampling, a revised Human Health Risk Assessment (“HHRA”), and an Ecological Risk Screening Assessment (“ERSA”) for the project site. On May 18, 2009, Mirant Willow Pass sent a notice pursuant to Section 1716(f) of the Commission’s regulations to inform staff and the Committee that additional time would be needed to complete the requested sampling and to prepare the revised HHRA and the ERSA.


Since that time, Mirant Willow Pass and staff have had further discussions to clarify the information that staff requires in the area of Waste Management. Mirant Willow Pass is in the process of preparing responses to staff’s questions regarding the role of the previous owner of the project site, which retained responsibility for certain environmental remediation at the site, and regarding the previous owner’s plans for conducting certain sampling at the site. Mirant Willow Pass will submit additional information on this topic to staff as soon as possible.

Staff has stated that the Preliminary Staff Assessment will be issued approximately 30 days after the Bay Area Air Quality Management District issues its Preliminary

Determination of Compliance (“PDOC”) for the project. Mirant Willow Pass understands that the PDOC remains in progress.
