NOTICE OF HEARING, DECISION, AND ORDER

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Siting Committee of the California Energy Commission has scheduled a first-phase Evidentiary Hearing in the above–captioned matter, as follows:

Purpose of Hearing

On June 3, 2009, the Association of Cornmunity Organizations for Reform Now (ACORN) filed a Complaint alleging noncompliance with a Commission Decision against Gateway Generating Station (GGS) pursuant to Cal. Code Regs., tit. 20 §1237. Similar complaints were filed by Local Clean Energy Alliance on June 29, 2009 and by CARE on July 17, 2009.

The Siting Committee (Committee) has found that there is good cause to set the matter for a hearing on the Complaints. The Committee will hear the evidence on the complaints in two phases. The first phase will be limited to the question of whether GGS

has failed to comply with the Final Decision of May 30, 2001. The Complainants will have the burden of proving non-compliance by a preponderance of evidence. After hearing all the evidence on the question of non-compliance, the Committee will issue a Decision. If the Committee finds in favor of GGS, there will be no further hearings on the matter. If the Committee finds non-compliance, in favor of the Complainants, the Committee will Notice a second phase hearing, at a later date, limited to the issue of penalty. After hearing all the evidence on the question of penalty, the Committee will issue an Order setting any administrative civil penalty.

Prehearing Statements

Each party shall serve and file a **Prehearing Statement**. Each party's Prehearing Statement shall be provided to and received by the other parties and the Commission's Docket Unit, 1516 9th Street, MS-15, Sacramento, California 95814-5512, **no later than 3:00 p.m., Friday, July 31, 2009**. The parties shall e-mail their statements to the Hearing Officer as well as to the Docket Unit and the parties as indicated on the Proof-of-Service list.

Each Prehearing Statement shall set forth under a separate heading:

- 1. The identity of each witness called to testify; a brief summary of the testimony to be offered by each witness; qualifications of each witness; and the time required to present direct testimony by each witness.
- 2. A list identifying exhibits and declarations that each party intends to offer into evidence and a brief summary of its relevance to the proceedings. Each document shall be numbered and identified on an **Exhibit List:**
- ACORN's documents shall be numbered consecutively as Exhibits 1-99.
- Local Clean Energy Alliance's documents shall be numbered consecutively as Exhibits 100-199.
- CARE's documents shall be numbered consecutively as Exhibits 200 299.
- PG&E's documents shall be numbered consecutively as Exhibits 300 399.
- Staff's documents shall be numbered consecutively as Exhibits 400-499.

DECISION

Pursuant to Cal. Code Regs., tit. 20 §1237, Staff's motion to dismiss the Complaint for insufficiency or lack of merit is **DENIED**.

The Complaints of ACORN, Local Clean Energy Alliance and CARE are consolidated into a single proceeding due to indenticality of issues.

The Petition to Intervene attached to the Complaint of CARE is moot in light of their status as real parties in interest as complainants. Therefore, the Petition is **DENIED**.

ORDER

PG&E is ordered to appear as a party in the above-noticed Evidentiary Hearing and file a Prehearing Statement in accordance with this Notice, Decision, and Order. Additionally, PG&E is ordered to answer the Complaints and respond to the following questions in its Prehearing Statement:

- 1. Has GGS begun commercial operation?
- 2. If GGS has been operating commercially, when did commercial operations begin?
- 3. Is GGS operating in conformity with the Conditions of Certification specified in the May 30, 2001 Final Decision on the Application for Certification including all subsequent Amendments to those Conditions of Certification approved by the Energy Commission?
- 4. Has GGS implemented the modifications specified in the May 7, 2009 Petition to Amend the project?
- 5. If the answer to question 4 is "yes," when were the modifications specified in the May 7, 2009 Petition to Amend the project implemented?
- If any modifications described in questions 4 and 5 above require changes to any Conditions of Certification in the Final Decision or in subsequent amendments approved by the Energy Commission, please specify which Conditions of Certification require changes.
