- 1. They had not received the socioeconomic data requests for the Solar 2 Supplement to the AFC.
- The Seeley Wastewater Treatment Plant Upgrade has been going on for years and has a separate CEQA document. It would have been done without Solar 2. Financial assistance by the applicant for the Seeley Wastewater Treatment Plant Upgrade is so they can receive the water quicker.
- 3. They agree that the two transmission line projects, Sunrise Powerlink Project and the Green Path transmission line project, have both indirect and cumulative impacts.
