1. <u>Issues.</u> The June 12, 2009 Issues Identification Report identified six potential Issues: Biological Resources, Land Use, Visual Resources, Water and Soils, Reliability and Cultural Resources. CEC Staff, BLM personnel and Applicant (SES) have been diligently

Pursuant to the Committee Scheduling Order dated July 29, 2009, the Applicant hereby submits

working on resolving these issues. Subsequently, CEC and BLM have filed Data Requests Set 1, Parts 1 and 2. To date, the Applicant has responded to all CEC and BLM Data Requests with the exception of Air Quality, Public Health and Safety, Cultural Resources, and Soils and Water. The Applicant will docket responses to Air Quality (Data Responses 1-48), Public Health and Safety (Data Requests 109-112) and the Drainage, Erosion and Sediment Control Plan (Data Request 81) on August 31, 2009. The Applicant is continuing work on responses to the remaining Data Requests and will docket as soon as possible.

2. <u>Schedule.</u> A project schedule was included in the Committee's Scheduling Order, dated July 29, 2009. SES believes the Committee's schedule is feasible and encourages all parties to proceed according to this schedule as the objective, as SES is committed to doing so. The Applicant would like to stress the importance of starting construction in December 2010 in order to qualify for Department of Energy Federal grant funding.

3. <u>Public Comment.</u> The Informational Hearing/Site Visit and Scoping meeting held on June 22, 2009 included opportunities for public comment. Numerous members of the public took advantage of this opportunity to ask questions of the Applicant and the agencies. These questions were in many areas, including water resources, biological resources, alternatives and cumulative impacts. On July 30, 2009 the Applicant responded to these public questions.
