

## Purpose

The summit will provide information on Industry Sector Strategy Approaches, an overview of the Clean Energy Industry, an introduction to California's Green Workforce Initiative sponsored by the Green Collar Jobs Council, and a review of the Employment Training Panel's current and proposed Green Initiatives. The CWIB will also review the planned approach for responding to the Department of Labor's State Energy Sector Partnership and Training Grants Solicitation.

The second part of the day the EDD will provide a review of the California Clean Energy Workforce Training Program Solicitation for Proposal (SFP) and address any questions.

## Background

The California Energy Commission, CWIB, and EDD are announcing a statewide Solicitation for Proposal (SFP) for the California Clean Energy Workforce Training Program. This collaborative effort combines funding from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) for the State Energy Program (SEP), Workforce Investment Act Governor's Discretionary funds, and the Alternative and Renewable Fuel and Vehicle Technology Program established by AB 118 (Núñez, Chapter 750, Statutes of 2007). These funds and locally leveraged funds are expected to serve as the foundation for the largest "green" initiative in the nation.
