Subject: **SAN JOAQUIN SOLAR 1 & 2 HYBRID PROJECT (08-AFC-12) STATUS REPORT 4**

Staff submits the following Status Report for the proposed San Joaquin Solar 1 & 2 Hybrid Project (SJS), pursuant to the Committee Scheduling Order dated May 7, 2009.

Current Issues and Activities for Resolution

Staff continues to work through the discovery and analysis phase of the proposed SJS project Application for Certification (AFC). Staff has received a complete set of data responses on July 15, 2009, and a Data Response/Issues Resolution Workshop was held on August 6, 2009, in Sacramento. Based on discussions at the workshop the applicant provided supplemental responses in the areas of Air Quality, Land Use, Public Health, Soils/Water, and Waste Management on August 28, 2009. Staff is now reviewing the additional information.

Agency Actions and Comments

Concerns were raised by The California Department of Toxic Substance Control regarding toxic waste on the site. Additional testing and sampling is being performed to determine the level of contamination. The California Department of Fish and Game and The Fish and Wildlife Service have concerns that the project would impact the habitat and movement activities of the San Joaquin Kit Fox. Further analysis and studies may be required that would delay determinations from these agencies. A staff workshop is being planned for late September to resolve these issues. In addition, the San Joaquin Valley Air Quality Management District is delayed in issuing the Preliminary Determination of Compliance (PDOC) due to extra time required to analysis new information submitted by the applicant. The PDOC is expected by September 11, 2009.

Schedule

Staff continues to be as productive as possible, in light of the three mandatory furlough days each month and in addition to the significant curtailment in staff's ability to work overtime. At this time staff anticipates the publication of the Preliminary Staff Assessment will be delayed, reflecting the additional time required by staff to analyze the new data recently provided by the applicant, and resolve new issues. Staff is now working towards the following departure from the initial Committee Scheduling Order of May 7, 2009.
