Dear Commissioners Byron and Levin:

Since Status Report #4 filed August 7, 2009, we have made considerable progress both in responding to the CEC staff's final data requests and making commitments to preparing the Solar Two project for future construction and operation.

The only data requests currently outstanding are #142–150 dealing with resurvey work and additional information required for cultural resources. The resurvey work for the 25% sample has been completed relying on the guidance and priorities of CEC and BLM staff and has included inspections of the work by both agencies. Approximately 80 site forms (which comprise the 25% sample), and responses to Data Requests 142-150 will be submitted to the CEC and BLM no later than October 15, 2009.

Data Requests 145 and 146 deal with special ethnographic studies, modeling of potential traditional use areas, and potential visual impacts to these unknown traditional use areas. We have already begun formal consultation with Native American Tribes, have had Native Americans monitor our on-the-ground survey activities, and met with three different Tribal representatives and toured areas on and off the site with them. A number of off-site traditional use areas were identified and the project's potential visual intrusion on these sites was previously discussed in response to Data Request 119. We realize that there is a potential for other unknown traditional use areas to be identified through continued outreach requested by the staff and are in the process of seeking additional ethnographic information. However, because the effort conducted to date is consistent with State and Federal practices for CEQA and NEPA compliance documentation respectively at this stage, we have asked the CEC to allow us to provide further response to these two data requests after the PSA/DEIS is published and during the Section 106 process and before the FSA/FEIS is published. It is our understanding that the staff agrees with submitting this data after the PSA/DEIS is published.

Regarding the future of our project, Stirling Energy Systems has submitted the required application for federal loan guarantees and is in the process of committing substantial funds for necessary equipment, utility interconnections, and manufacturing. To qualify for federal funds and the related benefits for California and meet other obligations, it is critical for us to begin construction before the fourth quarter of 2010. If the schedule follows the timelines laid out in the Committee's Scheduling Order, we request that the staff publish the PSA/DEIS by

November 16, 2009, approximately a month after the final data responses are submitted. We are also willing to work with the staff on an alternative schedule that allows for a decision before the end of the third quarter of 2010.

Because of the importance of the schedule for meeting the federal timeframes, we request that the Committee require the staff and applicant to submit monthly status reports describing both status of activity moving toward a decision and progress toward resolving issues. We also request that the Committee hold one or more scheduling conferences between publication of the PSA/DEIS and the FSA/FEIS. This will allow the Committee to understand the progress of resolving issues during the workshop process preceding Committee hearings.

In the 11½ months since we were determined to be data adequate, we have been impressed with the dedication and professionalism of most of the CEC staff. During that time we have become extremely concerned about the staff's significant workload, their lack of resources, and the restrictions in their time. We stand ready to assist the Commission in any way we can to obtain additional resources to perform the work for the solar projects eligible for federal funds.
