On July 27, 2009, California Unions for Reliable Energy ("CURE") served its third set of data requests on the Applicant, San Joaquin Solar 1 and 2 ("SJS").¹ On August 17, 2009, SJS served its "Objections to Data Requests of California Unions For Reliable Energy, Set 3".² None of SJS's objections contained any accusations against CURE based on CURE's status as a coalition of unions. However, its response to CURE's petition to compel production of information contained a series of extreme accusations about CURE that have nothing to do with the merits of the data requests nor the issues that the Commission must consider in evaluating the Application.³ Since SJS makes these same accusations in its objections to CURE's fourth set of data requests, rather than filing a series of repetitive responses, CURE will address them in a petition to compel production of information in response to set four, which will be filed by October 14, 2009.

Therefore, in the interest of administrative efficiency, CURE recommends that the Committee consolidate its decisions on CURE's petition to compel information in response to set three and CURE's forthcoming petition to compel information in response to set four.
