Mr. Booth is head of the unit in the South Lake Tahoe RWQCB office; this office has taken over all the solar applications that were originally being reviewed at the Victorville office. He stated that he was not aware that bioremediation would be occurring for soils less than 10,000 mg/kg at PHPP. He said that the RWQCB would need the applicant to provide information on how the land treatment unit would be constructed as well as information on the treatment process. Mr. Booth indicated that the RWQCB would probably not issue formal Waste Discharge Requirements. They would likely send a letter to the Energy Commission that indicated how the applicant should construct and operate the HTF land treatment unit, based on the information provided by the applicant. The RWQCB may require monitoring at the land treatment unit. Mr. Booth will be contacting the Energy Commission about getting information from the applicant.
