Staff Comments on Schedule

On October 26, 2009, the Committee designated by the Energy Commission to conduct proceedings on the Application for Certification (AFC) for the Solar One Energy Project issued a Notice of Committee Conference and directed parties to submit comments regarding the suitability of applying the basic concepts of the "Renewable Energy Action Team Milestones to Permit California Renewable Portfolio Standard Energy Projects by December 2010" to the Solar One Energy Project. Staff is keenly aware of the interest in ensuring that renewable energy projects currently before the Energy Commission for licensing are reviewed in an expeditious manner. Although there have been some delays in obtaining the information needed to complete a staff analysis, staff is prepared to work diligently to assist the Solar One Energy Project in obtaining a license prior to December 2010. To that end, staff prepared the attached schedule, which was also submitted as part of Staff's October 27, 2009 Status Report. Adherence to this schedule, which assumes that the water supply plan presented in the AFC -- and not the two alternatives identified in the October 1, 2009 Interim Status Report -- is analyzed, would allow a license to issue by November 1, 2010. We note that the schedule may need to be modified to allow for a second evidentiary hearing after the Supplemental SA is filed, which could affect the date of the final decision.
