

Notice of Staff Workshop on Data Requests for the Blythe Solar Power Project (09-AFC-6)

The California Energy Commission staff will conduct a workshop for the proposed Blythe Solar Power Project to discuss staff's data requests and to work towards resolving issues. All interested agencies and members of the public are invited to participate.

PURPOSE

The purpose of the workshop is to allow staff, the applicant, interested agencies, and the public to discuss staff's data requests issued on November 30, 2009, and to work towards resolving project issues. Subjects to be discussed include: Alternatives, Biological Resources, Cultural Resources and Soil & Water Resources. Other technical areas of the data requests may be discussed as necessary.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

On August 24, 2009, the California Energy Commission received an Application For Certification (AFC) from Solar Millennium, LLC and Chevron Energy Solutions to construct and operate the Blythe Solar Power Project in Riverside County.

The Blythe Solar Power Project (project) is a concentrated solar thermal electric generating facility with four adjacent, independent, and identical units of 250 megawatt (MW) nominal capacity each for a total nominal capacity of 1,000 MW. The project is proposed to be located in the southern California inland desert, approximately eight miles

PROOF OF SERVICE (REVISED 11/18/09) FILED WITH ORIGINAL MAILED FROM SACRAMENTO ON 11/30/09 west of the city of Blythe and two miles north of the Interstate-10 freeway in Riverside County, California. The applicants are seeking a right-of-way grant for approximately 9,400 acres of lands owned by the Federal government and administered by the Bureau of Land Management (BLM). Construction and operation of the project would disturb a total of about 7,030 acres.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Over the coming months, the Energy Commission will conduct a number of public workshops and hearings to determine whether the proposed project should be approved for construction and operation and, if so, under what set of conditions. The workshops will provide the public as well as local, state and federal agencies the opportunity to participate in reviewing the proposed project. The Energy Commission will issue notices for these workshops and hearings at least ten days prior to the meeting.
