Energy Commission's Role


- Energy Commission (CEC) Permitting Authority
 - Thermal power plants "50 Megawatts or Greater"
 - Related facilities:
 - electric transmission lines to first point of interconnection
 - water supply pipelines
 - natural gas pipelines
 - access roads
- Lead state agency for California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA)

- 1. Data Adequacy
 - Minimum requirements to accept application
- 2. Staff Discovery and Analyses
 - Issues Identification
 - Data requests
 - Public Workshops (1st was held yesterday 12/8)
 - Staff Assessments (SA)
- 3. Committee Evidentiary Hearing and Decision
 - Evidentiary Hearings on SA and other information
 - Presiding Member's Proposed Decision (PMPD)
 - PMPD hearing and Commission decision




Discovery and Analysis Process

- Determine if proposal complies with Laws,
 Ordinances, Regulations, Standards (LORS)
- Conduct engineering and environmental analysis
 - Identify issues
 - Evaluate alternatives
 - Identify mitigation measures
 - Recommend Conditions of Certification
- Facilitate public and agency participation
- Staff products: Staff Assessment (SA) and Supplement to the Staff Assessment (SA)
- Make recommendations to the Committee



Evidentiary Hearing & Decision Process





Evidentiary Hearing & Decision Process

- Committee conducts evidentiary hearings
 - Issues Presiding Member's Proposed Decision (PMPD)
 - PMPD contains:
 - Findings regarding environmental impacts, public health, engineering
 - Findings regarding project's compliance with LORS
 - Conditions of certification
 - Discussion regarding agency/public comments
 - Recommends whether or not to approve the project
- Full Commission makes decision
- Energy Commission monitors compliance with all conditions of certification, for the life of the project and closure

Local, State and Federal Agencies

- Staff works closely with local, state and federal agencies, for example:

Staff's Issues Identification Report

Purpose

- Inform participants of potential issues
- Early focus on important topics

Criteria

- Significant impacts that may be difficult to mitigate
- Potential non-compliance with LORS
- Potential conflicts between parties that could delay schedule

Potential Issues

Water Resources



Water Resources Concern

- Staff wants to ensure that the project will not result in significant impacts to other users.
- Staff has concerns about groundwater pumping in the Mojave River Basin.
- Staff has concerns that project pumping in this portion of the basin could change hydraulic gradients and cause migration of impaired groundwater.
- The Energy Commission staff will be working with the Mojave Water Agency and the Mojave Water Agency watermaster to fully evaluate potential impacts and feasible mitigation.



Staff's Proposed Schedule

- Meeting this schedule will depend on:
 - Applicant's timely response to staff's data requests.
 - Required actions by other local, state, and federal agencies.
 - Resolution of the identified issues.
 - The proposed AMS project, qualifies for the 12month licensing process.

Post-Licensing Project Compliance Oversight

- If the project is approved:
 - The Compliance phase would apply during construction, operation & decommissioning
 - Purpose: To assure compliance with all Conditions of Certification and applicable LORS
 - Compliance Project Manager (CPM) provides oversight of construction and operation.
