## **COMMENTS:**

BP Watson (Cindy Kyle-Fisher, Ross Metersky, and Chris Ellison) had a few clarification questions regarding Data Request Set #2, which CEC Soil&Water staff (Mark Lindley) was able to answer. BP Watson wanted clarification on Data Request 43 in regards to whether the request was focused on the 5<sup>th</sup> train or rather the whole BP Watson Facility.

Data Request 43 asked to provide information regarding the availability and feasibility of replacing the existing fresh water supplies with additional recycled or other alternative water supply.

CEC staff wanted the request to encompass the whole Facility. The project will be using 5800 afy reclaimed water and staff would like to know if it will cover the rest of the water supply that the Facility will be using in the future. Staff was concerned over groundwater supply at the project site, because at that site, there are beginnings of seawater intrusion, which is a cause for concern. In addition, the water district limits the amount of groundwater pumped in the project site in the winter, in order to let the groundwater recharge.
