COMMENTS: I called Mr. Minnick to see if he had any concerns about the project with respect to visual resources or traffic and transportation. He has reviewed the amendment petition, attended the site visit and is familiar with the area. Mr. Minnick said that there are a number of operating geothermal plants that emit plumes and adding another facility with similar plumes would not be a significant visual change. He also noted that traffic flows have not increased in the local area since the original Salton Sea Unit 6 was reviewed in 2002-3.
