

PROPOSED NEW POWER PLANT, NORTHEASTERN ALAMEDA COUNTY

The California Energy Commission has received an application for a permit to build a new 200-MW, natural-gas-fired power plant, east of Livermore (Alameda County) and west of Tracy (San Joaquin County). The plant site is located in **T2S R3E**, **Sec. 1** on the Clifton Court Forebay USGS quadrangle.

A portion of the Energy Commission's permitting process involves notifying citizens and addressing their concerns. We anticipate holding public workshops and hearings in the future, and we would like to notify representatives of the Native American community concerning the time and place of these public workshops.
