CNPS submits the following voucher records for 6 taxa that either occur nearer or at lower elevations to the Ivanpah SEGS site than what is presented in the applicant's Rebuttal Testimony, Table Bio-1. This data amendment is presented in an effort to provide the best available data on the distribution of these primarily late summer/fall-flowering species as they relate as potentially occurring in the Ivanpah SEGS.

For the Record:

- 1. Bouteloua eriopoda: Nearest known occurrence: J. Andre #8665 (UCR 195822), collected November 9, 2007, located approx. 2.5 miles northwest of project. Elevation 4028 ft.
- 2. Bouteloua trifida: Nearest known occurrence: J. Andre #9800 (UCR, Victor Valley College), collected September 23, 2008, located approx. 1.5 miles north of project. Elevation 3389 ft.
- 3. Cordylanthus parviflorus: Nearest known occurrence: J. Andre #10965 (GMDRC 3611), collected October 1, 2009, south end of Ivanpah Valley approximately 10 miles south of ISEGS. Elevation 4193 ft.
- 4. Euphorbia extipulata: Lowest known elevation occurrence: J. Andre #10964 (to UCR), collected October 1, 2009, south end of Ivanpah Valley approximately 10 miles south of ISEGS. Elevation 4193 ft. Voucher records down to at least 2000 ft elevation in Arizona.
- 5. Muhlenbergia pauciflora: Nearest known occurrence: James Henrickson #12705 (RSA 487286), collected August 30, 1973, 15 mi. air miles to ISEGS in New York Mts, in granitic open arroyo that heads to summit of Mountains from road to mine in upper Fourth of July Canyon. Elevation 6000 ft.
- 6. Physalis lobata: Nearest known occurrence: J. Andre #8621 (GMDRC 2484, UCR, UNLV), collected April 8, 2008, Ivanpah Valley, just southeast of I-15 at Primm in NV, 5-6 mi. E. of ISEGS. Elevation 2628
- 7. Sanvitalia abertii: Lowest known elevation occurrence: J. Andre #11025 (GMDRC 3648, UCR), collected September 22, 2009, south end of Ivanpah Valley, approximately 10 mi. south of ISEGS. Elevation 4035 ft.
