1. On December 29, 2009, a Petition to Intervene in the above-captioned proceeding was filed by:

- 2. The Petition was timely filed and contains the information required by section 1207 of the Commission's regulations (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 20, § 1207);
- 3. No party or other person has filed an opposition to said Petition; and
- 4. Petitioners' stated interests in potential air quality, noise, visual, public health, and socioeconomic impacts resulting from the proposed project constitute grounds for intervention. However, Petitioners' requests for compensatory damages and allegations regarding diminution in property values do not constitute grounds for intervention as they are not reasonably connected to the Commission's proceedings.

THEREFORE, the Committee Orders that the Petition to Intervene in this matter be GRANTED on the grounds set forth above and that Petitioners be placed upon the Proof of Service List as Intervenors. Each Petitioner may exercise the rights and shall fulfill the obligations of a party as set forth in Section 1712 of the Commission's regulations. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 20, § 1712.)

The Application for Certification in this matter was deemed data adequate on January 28, 2009. Under the Commission's regulations, all data requests in this matter were required to be submitted by no later than July 27, 2009, unless the Committee allowed, or allows, untimely requests for good cause shown. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 20, § 1716.) The Committee will not permit unnecessary, irrelevant or unreasonably burdensome data requests and may, on the motion of a party or on its own motion, exercise its authority pursuant to sections 1203 and 1204 (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 20, §§ 1203, 1204) to enforce the provisions of section 1716, setting forth procedures for obtaining information (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 20, § 1716), in order to eliminate undue delay in the completion of these proceedings.

Further, the Executive Director or her designee shall ensure that Petitioners are immediately provided with a copy of the Application for Certification.
