On January 6, 2010 you email us the Traffic and Transportation Section within the Environmental Document for the Hector Road Solar Power Plant for review. We have the following comments:

- 1. The existing condition analysis shall use the peak hour factor from the traffic counts. For the future year conditions, use 0.95.
- 2. The study shall include the future buildout year 2035. Any mitigation shall show a cost and a fair share for the project.
- 3. Caltrans needs to review and comment on this document. Please share their comments with us.
- 4. Our 24 hour two-way traffic count, taken in April 2007 on National Trails Highway at this location is 164. Revise page 5.11-4.
- 5. On page 5.11-10, The County acceptable Level of Service in the Desert Area is C. not D.
