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APPLICANT’S STATUS REPORT NO. 2

In accordance with the Committee Scheduling Order dated December 17, 2009, Abengoa Solar Inc (the “Applicant”) submits the second monthly status report in this proceeding. On August 10, 2009, the Applicant submitted an Application for Certification ("AFC") for the proposed Abengoa Mojave Solar Project. The AFC was determined to be data adequate on October 21, 2009.

Staff promulgated two sets of data requests, Data Request Set 1A (nos. 1-93) and Data Request Set 1B (nos. 1-86) on October 22, 2009 and October 26, 2009, respectively.

This status report provides an update regarding progress toward completing responses to data requests issued by Commission Staff and summarizes the filings made by Applicant.

Applicant Filings

Responses to Staff Data Requests

The Applicant submitted a Replacement Written Response to Data Request Set 1B, Item 84, and provided other information requested by Staff regarding Visual Resources on January 12, 2010.

In addition, the Applicant submitted a Surface Soil Testing Plan in response to requests from Staff regarding Waste Management.

The Applicant submitted a Supplemental Written Response to Set 1A for Air Quality and Public Health on January 11, 2010. The Applicant also requested additional time to complete modeling and technical analysis of certain Data Request 17 and 85 in Set 1A. After discussions with Staff at the Staff Workshop on January 15, 2010 and the Continuance Workshop on January 20, 2010, the Applicant revised several data requests for Air Quality and Public Health, and completed the responses to Data Requests 17 and 85 in its Second Supplemental Written Response to Set 1A for Air Quality and Public Health filed on February 2, 2010. This completes the Applicant's response to Data Request Set 1A.

The Applicant submitted supplemental responses to Set 1B addressing the Data Requests for Cultural Resources, for which the Applicant requested additional time, including Data Requests 10, 11, 15, and 16, on January 5, 2010. The Applicant will submit final testing reports for Cultural Resources to complete the responses to Data Requests 11 and 16 and will submit the forms requested by Data Requests 12 and 17 as soon as laboratory results are received and evaluated. The Applicant expects to submit these responses next week. This will complete the Applicant's response to Data Request Set 1B.
