

RE: California Energy Commission Draft 2006 RPS Verification Report; Comments of Community Energy, Inc. Regarding Renewables Portfolio Standard Procurement

Dear Commissioner,

Community Energy, Inc. ("CEI") appreciates the opportunity to provide comments on this Renewables Portfolio Standard 2006 Procurement Verification Draft Staff Report. CEI supports the recommendations made in the Draft 2006 RPS Verification Report, wherein generation from Mountain View I & II wind facilities is ineligible for compliance with the California RPS by Southern California Edison. Furthermore, most of the renewable energy certificates generated from Mountain View I & II were sold into the voluntary renewable energy credit market and CEI strongly believes that the integrity of all voluntary transactions between Mountain View I & II and all current and prior owners with contractual rights to the renewable energy certificates are upheld. This determination by the California Energy Commission and the California Public Utility Commission is necessary to ensure the integrity of contracts and marketing claims and provide stability in the voluntary market, as well as clear guidance for the compliance markets.
