Purpose of Prehearing Conference

The Prehearing Conference is a public forum where the Committee will assess the parties' readiness for an evidentiary hearing, identify areas of agreement or dispute, and discuss the remaining schedule and procedures necessary to conclude the certification process. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 20, § 1718.5.)

At the Prehearing Conferences, all parties (Staff, Applicant, and Intervenors) shall present their respective positions regarding: the substantive topic areas ready for evidentiary hearing; those topics that require further analysis, including the nature of, and time frame for, any such analysis; the topic areas that have been resolved; and the topic areas that are disputed and require adjudication. The parties shall also identify proposed witnesses, as well as the time required for direct testimony and/or cross-examination.

We invite Bureau of Land Management (BLM) representatives to attend the Prehearing Conference and Evidentiary Hearings to facilitate coordination of BLM's process with this AFC process.

Local, state, and federal governmental agencies may participate at the Prehearing Conferences and Evidentiary Hearing, as necessary. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 20, § 1714.5.) Elected officials and members of the public may present public comments at these events and/or submit written comments to the Energy Commission's Docket Unit. Please include "Docket No. 08-AFC-5" on any written comments.

Prehearing Conference Statements

Each party is **ORDERED** to serve and file a **PREHEARING CONFERENCE STATEMENT** containing all of the information described below. The parties shall e-mail and/or mail their statements to the Hearing Officer, to the parties as indicated on the Proof-of-Service list, and submit both e-mail and paper copy to the Commission's Docket Unit, 1516 9th Street, MS-4, Sacramento, California 95814-5512, so as to be received **NO LATER than 4 P.M. on Monday, March 15, 2010**. The parties shall also submit a **Word version** of their statements to the Hearing Officer via e-mail.

NOTE: FAILURE TO FILE A PREHEARING CONFERENCE STATEMENT BY THE DEADLINE MAY PRECLUDE A PARTY FROM PARTICIPATING AT THE PREHEARING CONFERENCE AND EVIDENTIARY HEARING.

Each statement shall specify:

- 1. The topic areas that are complete and ready to proceed to evidentiary hearing;
- 2. The topic areas that are not complete and not yet ready to proceed to evidentiary hearing, and the reasons therefor;
- 3. The topic areas that remain disputed and require adjudication, and the precise nature of the dispute for each topic;
- 4. The identity of each witness sponsored by each party (**note**: expert witnesses must demonstrate professional expertise in their area(s) of testimony); the topic area(s) which each witness will present; a brief summary of the testimony to be offered by each witness; qualifications of each witness; and the time required to present direct testimony by each witness;
- Topic areas upon which a party desires to cross-examine witnesses, a summary of the scope of such cross-examination, and the time desired for such crossexamination;
- 6. A list identifying exhibits and declarations that each party intends to offer into evidence and the technical topics to which they apply (see following section on format):
- 7. Briefing dates (if needed) and other scheduling matters;

8. For all topics, the parties shall review the Proposed Conditions of Certification listed in the Staff Assessment (SA) for enforceability, comprehension, and consistency with the evidence, and submit any proposed modifications.

Format for Presenting Written Testimonial and Documentary Evidence

In addition to the witness lists and exhibit lists provided with the Prehearing Conference Statements, the parties shall also provide copies of their written testimonial and documentary evidence **ON OR BEFORE the dates shown in the schedule above**. They shall also provide it to the Committee in two formats, as follows.

NOTE: FAILURE TO EXCHANGE WRITTEN TESTIMONIAL AND DOCUMENTARY EVIDENCE BY THE DEADLINE MAY PRECLUDE A PARTY FROM PARTICIPATING AT THE EVIDENTIARY HEARING.

- Format 1. Each document shall be numbered and identified on an Exhibit List. (See attached sample Exhibit List.)
 - Applicant's exhibits shall be numbered consecutively as *Exhibits 1 through 299*. *Exhibit 1* shall be the Application for Certification. (note: provide the AFC only upon request);
 - Staff's exhibits shall be numbered consecutively as *Exhibits 300* through 399. *Exhibit 300* shall be the Staff Analysis. (note: provide the Staff Analysis only upon request);
 - Intervenor CURE's exhibits shall be numbered consecutively as *Exhibits 400 through 499.*

Printed copies of each party's exhibits, including intervenors' exhibits, organized as described under Format No. 1, above, shall be submitted to all other parties, including intervenors, the Hearing Officer, and the Committee, on or before the dates shown in the schedule above.

Format 2. To facilitate the Committee's efficient organization and review of the exhibits, printed copies of Applicant's exhibits for each topic area shall also be compiled in separate file folders designated by topic with the appropriate Exhibit Number attached to each document. This compilation shall include all opening and rebuttal testimony filed by Applicant and shall be provided to the Hearing Officer NO LATER than April 15, 2010.

Presentation of their exhibits by other parties in similar fashion would be helpful to the Committee, but is not mandatory.

Petitions to Intervene to Become a Formal Party

The Energy Commission's Decision on the Solar Two Power Project will be based on the official evidentiary record developed at the Evidentiary Hearing. Only formal parties (Applicant, Staff, and Intervenors) may present evidence and cross-examine witnesses at the Evidentiary Hearing. Public comment may not, by itself, support a finding or conclusion in the Decision but the Committee may consider it to the extent it can supplement formal written or oral testimony sponsored by a party.

Anyone with an appropriate interest in the Project may file a Petition to Intervene and become a formal party. At the Evidentiary Hearing, a formal party may offer testimony and documentary evidence and cross-examine witnesses. A formal party must also comply with Committee orders, procedures, and filing requirements, and is subject to discovery and having its own witnesses cross-examined by other parties.

The DEADLINE to file a Petition to Intervene in this case is MONDAY, MARCH 22, 2010. Petitions filed after that date and time extensions for new Intervenors to review case materials may be granted only upon a showing by the Petitioner that extraordinary circumstances made it impossible to file by the deadline, in the judgment of the Committee.

Public Participation and Public Adviser

Members of the public are welcome to attend and offer comments at the Prehearing Conference and the Evidentiary Hearing. It is not necessary to be an Intervenor to participate in the public process.

We encourage the public to submit comments prior to or during the Evidentiary Hearings but will accept comments made following the Evidentiary Hearings until the close of the 90-day comment period on the DEIS, which began on February 26, 2010 and will end on May 27, 2010.

Comments made after the Evidentiary Hearings may be discussed in the Presiding Member's Proposed Decision (PMPD) or treated and discussed as comments on the PMPD, in the Committee's discretion. Comments made to BLM or the Energy Commission will be shared with the other agency.
