Calico AFC parties:

Attached, as promised at our February 23 status conference, is a marked up version of the current Committee Schedule. It took me longer than expected to finish this because additional information trickled in following our conference.

Our schedule assumed that the SA/DEIS publication by CEC staff and BLM's publication of the Notice of Availability could be on the same day. I now hear that it cannot happen that way. Once staff has the final document ready, they must overnight it to Washington. If it is received on a Friday, the NOA can be published on the following Friday. So if Staff finishes on April 1st (March 31 is a holiday), the NOA could be published on April 9, starting the 90-day comment period. Staff's completion of the document in turn hinges on BLM returning its comments to Staff by March 19.

Based on this new information, a final CEC decision is projected for September 29. I don't know how the delay in the start of the 90-day DEIS comment period will affect BLM's ability to issue a decision before October.

Feel free to comment on the schedule in your status reports and at our next telephonic conference.

As a head's up, if staff schedules Imperial Valley (formerly Solar 2) staff workshops for March 23, we will likely move our March 23 conference to a day later that week. If that happens, a revised notice will be sent out. If you have any particular alternative date preferences, please reply with them; no guarantees, of course. The April and May dates will not change (unless another conflict arises). Also, note that the Committee has tentatively reserved May 25-27 on its calendars for evidentiary hearings.
