On February 5, 2010, the Northern California Power Agency (NCPA) submitted a compliance filing in conformance with Title 20, California Code of Regulations, Section 2909. Pursuant to Title 20, California Code of Regulations, Section 2910, the Executive Director recommended that the Energy Commission find the procurement in compliance with the Commission's SB1368 regulations.

Based on NCPA's compliance filing, the Executive Director's recommendation, and the absence of any opposition, at a regularly scheduled business meeting on February 24, 2010, the California Energy Commission found that NCPA's Lodi Energy Center (LEC), a proposed combined-cycle natural gas-fired electric generation facility currently being reviewed by the Energy Commission pursuant to an Application for Certification, complies with Title 20, California Code of Regulations, Section 2900 et seq. The LEC has a nameplate rating capacity of 296 megawatts, but will only deliver 280 megawatts of electricity to the grid pursuant to its interconnection agreement. In addition to finding the facility itself compliant, the Energy Commission found that the determination of compliance also extends to the long-term power sales agreement entered into by NCPA and several entities on January 28, 2010 for the output of the facility, and that such determination of compliance shall also extend to the addition of signatories to the agreement through February 24, 2011.
