If there appear to be no issues to discuss, the Committee may choose to cancel the Conference and will communicate that decision to the parties via e-mail.

The Conference may be conducted by the Hearing Officer with or without the Committee members present. These proceedings will not be formally transcribed but an electronic recording will be kept for later review, if necessary.
