General Plan and Zoning Consistency - Rice Solar Energy Project

Dear Ms. Way:

We received your letter requesting that we provide information concerning the consistency of the proposed Rice Solar Energy Project (the proposed project) with Riverside County's General Plan, Riverside County's zoning ordinance and any existing or expected land uses in the proposed project area. You have indicated that you need this information because the California Energy Commission (CEC) has permitting authority over the proposed project and will not initiate the permitting process until the County provides such information. You have further indicated that the proposed project would use solar energy to generate at least 50 megawatts of electricity and would be located in eastern Riverside County, approximately 20 miles west of the California-Arizona border, south of Highway 62, on assessor's parcel numbers 801-070-003, 801-070-004, 801-100-005, and 801-100-006.

The property underlying the proposed project is designated Open Space-Rural (OS-RUR) by the General Plan and is zoned Controlled Development Areas – 10 acre minimum (W-2-10). The OS-RUR General Plan land use designation is applied to remote, privately-owned open space areas with limited access and a lack of public services. While the OS-RUR General Plan land use designation does not specifically allow solar energy projects, we could find the proposed project consistent with the OS-RUR designation policies, as well as the General Plan Principals and Vision Statement which expressly encourage the development of renewable resources in Open Space designations. As stated in the General Plan Open Space Element Policies: "Energy conservation and the substitution of renewable resources should be encouraged if these resources are to be preserved for the County's future generations."

Pursuant to Section 15.1 of Riverside County's zoning ordinance (Ordinance No. 348), the W-2-10 zone allows a variety of public utility uses as a matter of right, including "structures and the pertinent facilities necessary and incidental to the development and transmission of electrical power and gas such as hydroelectric power plants, booster or conversion plants, transmission lines, pipe lines, and the like." These uses do not require the prior approval of a use permit. Although we would not consider the proposed project a public utility, it is substantially the same in character and intensity as these public utility uses. Accordingly, we could find the proposed project consistent with Ordinance No. 348. Because the current height limitation in the zone is 105 feet, however, we would first require the approval of a height variance for the proposed tower pursuant to Section 18.27 of Ordinance No. 348.

As for existing and expected land uses in the proposed project area, the majority of land surrounding this site is under Federal ownership and is designated Open Space-Rural on the County's General Plan and zoned

Natural Asset. Private land in the area is also designated Open Space-Rural by the General Plan and is zoned W-2-10, Controlled Development Area. There are no pending development applications on those privately owned parcels. I suggest that you contact the Bureau of Land Management to ascertain if there are development applications pending on the land under Federal Control.
