NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY OF THE STAFF ASSESSMENT FOR THE ALMOND 2 POWER PLANT PROJECT, APPLICATION FOR CERTIFICATION (09-AFC-2)

The California Energy Commission (Energy Commission) has prepared a Staff Assessment (SA) for the Almond 2 Power Plant Project (A2PP) Application for Certification (AFC). The SA contains the Energy Commission staff's engineering, public health, and environmental evaluation of the proposed A2PP. This notice is to inform you of the availability of the SA, which was published by the Energy Commission on April 30, 2010.

The Energy Commission encourages public and agency participation in the review of staff's SA. The SA will be available for a 30-day public comment period that will conclude on June 7, 2010. Written comments on the SA should be provided to Felicia Miller, Project Manager at the address on this letterhead (please add "Mail Stop 15") or by email to fmiller@energy.state.ca.us. Technical or project schedule questions should also be directed to Felicia Miller at (916) 654-4640, or by email.

The SA will serve as Energy Commission staff's testimony during evidentiary hearings held by the Energy Commission. The Energy Commission Committee assigned to the A2PP proceedings will consider and weigh the testimony, comments and recommendations of all interested parties, including Energy Commission staff, the applicant, intervenors, public, and other local, state, and federal agencies, before issuing the Presiding Member's Proposed Decision (PMPD) for consideration by the full Energy Commission. The public, intervenors, local, state and federal agencies are encouraged to participate in these hearings. The Energy Commission will issue notices at least 14 days prior to any scheduled hearings.

SUMMARY OF THE PROPOSED ALMOND 2 POWER PLANT PROJECT

The SA contains the Energy Commission staff's evaluation of the A2PP. The proposed 174-megawatt (MW) A2PP electric generating plant and related facilities are under the Energy Commission's licensing jurisdiction and cannot be constructed or operated without the Energy Commission's certification. The SA contains analyses similar to those normally contained in an Environmental Impact Report (EIR) required by the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). When issuing a license, the Energy Commission is the lead state agency under CEQA, and its process is functionally equivalent to the preparation of an EIR.

The Energy Commission staff has the responsibility to complete an independent assessment of the project's engineering design and its potential effects on the

environment, the public's health and safety, and whether the project conforms to all applicable laws, ordinances, regulations and standards (LORS). The staff also recommends measures to mitigate potential significant adverse environmental effects and conditions of certification for construction, operation and eventual closure of the project, if approved by the Energy Commission.

This SA is not the decision document for these proceedings, nor does it contain findings of the Energy Commission related to environmental impacts or the project's compliance with local/state/federal legal requirements. The SA serves as staff's official, sworn testimony in evidentiary hearings to be held by the Committee assigned to this proceeding, comprised of two Commissioners and a Hearing Officer. After evidentiary hearings, the Committee will consider testimony and comments presented by staff, the applicant, other parties to the proceeding, governmental agencies and the public – all aspects that comprise the official record of this proceeding – and issue a Presiding Member's Proposed Decision (PMPD). Following a public hearing, the full five-member Energy Commission will make its final decision on this power plant application based upon the PMPD, comments by parties to the proceeding and input from members of the public.
