#### **Background**

On May 28, 2009, HEI submitted a Revised AFC to the California Energy Commission to construct and operate an electrical generating plant near the unincorporated community of Tupman, in western Kern County, California. The HECA would be an integrated gasification combined cycle (IGCC), 250-megawatt (MW) power generation facility. The gasification block would also capture carbon from the raw syngas at steady-state operation, which would be transported to the Elk Hills Field for CO<sub>2</sub> EOR.

The proposed project would be located on a 473-acre site located approximately 7 miles west of the outermost edge of the city of Bakersfield and 1.5 miles northwest of Tupman. The site would be located near a hydrocarbon-producing area known as the Elk Hills Field, and is currently used primarily for agricultural purposes.


