Dear Certified Appliance Recycler:

Yesterday the California Energy Commission launched one of the state's largest residential consumer appliance recycling programs - the California Cash for Appliances rebate program.

Many of you have responded to my earlier letter, dated April 14, 2010, and are now partners with the Energy Commission implementing this program. Recycling inefficient appliances through a Certified Appliance Recycler (C.A.R.) is required for consumers to receive a rebate. As a Certified Appliance Recycler your participation is essential and key to the program's success. To ensure that consumers are able to document that their old appliance was properly recycled, they must attach the enclosed Proof of Recycling form with their application.

If you have not yet become a partner I want to ensure that you had a copy of this form to reproduce for your customers. When a consumer surrenders their old appliance for recycling, you will need to provide this form to them with your company information and your CAR certification number. Appliances that are a part of this program include refrigerators, clothes washers, and room air conditioners.
