Dear Ms. Jones:

Hydrogen Energy International, LLC ("Applicant") has proposed the Hydrogen Energy California Power Plant (08-AFC-8). In support of the Applicant's response to California Energy Commission Workshop Request No. 1, the Applicant has prepared a compact disc (CD) containing "GIS Shapefiles for the CO2 Linear and Landowner Information" (the "Submitted Record").

The Applicant requests that the Submitted Record be automatically designated as confidential pursuant to Title 20, California Code of Regulations, Section 2505(a)(5). In accordance with the Energy Commission's regulation, the Submitted Record has been marked as confidential and contains the specific location (latitude and longitude) of project-related CO2 facilities, and this information has not been previously released to the public. (See Title 20, California Code of Regulations, Sections 2505(a)(5)(A) & (B)(7).) Release of this information would create a potential security and public safety risk.

According to the Energy Commission's regulations, an application for confidential designation "shall be granted if the applicant makes a reasonable claim that the Public Records Act or other provision of law authorizes the Commission to keep the record confidential." (Title 20, California Code of Regulations, Section 2505(a)(3)(A).) The Applicant believes this

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letter establishes a reasonable claim for confidentiality based on the applicability of Title 20, California Code of Regulations, Section 2505(a)(5).

The Applicant requests that the entirety of the Submitted Record be kept confidential indefinitely, and that the Submitted Record not be disclosed even if aggregated with other information or redacted to conceal certain information to avoid a potential security and public safety risk. The Applicant has not disclosed any of the subject confidential information to anyone other than its employees, attorneys, consultants, others working as part of the project application before the Energy Commission, or others with a specific need for the information. This information has not been disclosed by the Applicant except on a "need-to-know" basis.
