Introduction

On May 26, 2010 the Committee for the Marsh Landing Generating Station issued its Notice of Prehearing Conference and Evidentiary Hearing. The notice requires that parties submit their prehearing conference statements by Monday June 27. While not yet accepted as an intervenor Robert Sarvey submits this prehearing conference statement to inform the Committee of the issues for adjudication in the event full Commission grants my intervention on June 30.

1. The topic areas that are complete and ready to proceed to evidentiary hearing;

All areas are complete and ready to proceed to evidentiary hearings.

2. The topic areas that are not complete and not yet ready to proceed to evidentiary hearing, and the reasons therefore;

All topics are ready.

3. The topic areas that remain disputed and require adjudication, and the precise nature of the dispute for each topic;

<u>Air Quality and Public Health</u>: A 5 ppm ammonia slip level should be required for the project. The projects cumulative impacts have not been fully assessed. The projects mitigation is inadequate as the ERC's all originate from the 1987 and 1990. Impacts to pockets of minority and low income residents have not been assessed. Cumulative transport issues to San Joaquin Valley are not addressed. PM-2.5 Health Impacts remain unanalyzed.

<u>Alternatives</u>: The projects original configuration with the FP-10 units is a viable alternative which lessens the significant impacts of the project. The project does not provide a reliable supply of electrical energy at a level consistent with the need for such energy.
