For the following reasons I urge the California Energy Commission to reject the relicensing of the California nuclear power plants:

- They sit on or near several earthquake faults.
- Adding 20 more years of high level nuclear waste to that accumulated since the mid-1980's would present a horrendous environmental and financial and ethical burden to future generations.
