## Required Filings and Format for Presenting Written Testimonial and Documentary Evidence not Previously Presented

On or before <u>Monday, July 26, 2010</u>, Applicant, Staff, and Intervenors shall each provide a CD or DVD of their additional evidence on the four topics noted in the Schedule to the Hearing Officer. Witness testimony shall be limited to those witnesses listed in the submissions of the parties.

The parties shall also provide copies of their written testimonial and documentary evidence (to the extent not previously provided) **ON OR BEFORE the dates shown in the schedule above**. They shall also provide it to the Committee in two formats, as follows.

## Format 1. Each document shall be numbered and identified on an **Exhibit List**. (See attached sample Exhibit List.)

- Applicant's exhibits shall be numbered consecutively as *Exhibits 1 through 299. Exhibit 1* shall be the Application for Certification. (note: provide the AFC only upon request);
- Staff's exhibits shall be numbered consecutively as Exhibits 300 through 399. Exhibit 300 shall be the Staff Assessment. (note: provide the Staff Assessment only upon request);
- Intervenor CURE's exhibits shall be numbered consecutively as *Exhibits* 400 through 499.
- Intervenor Tom Budlong's exhibits shall be numbered consecutively as **Exhibits 500 through 599.**
- Intervenor California Native Plant Society's exhibits shall be numbered consecutively as Exhibits 600 through 699.

• Intervenor Hossein Alimamaghani's exhibits shall be numbered consecutively as **Exhibits 700 through 799.** 

Printed copies of each party's additional exhibits, including Intervenors' exhibits, organized as described under Format No. 1, above, shall be submitted to all other parties, including intervenors, the Hearing Officer, and the Committee, on or before the dates shown in the schedule above.

Format 2. To facilitate the Committee's efficient organization and review of the exhibits, printed copies of Applicant's new exhibits for each topic area shall also be compiled in separate file folders designated by topic with the appropriate Exhibit Number attached to each document. This compilation shall include all new opening and rebuttal testimony filed by Applicant and shall be provided to the Hearing Officer NO LATER than July 26, 2010. Presentation of their exhibits by other parties in similar fashion would be helpful to the Committee, but is not mandatory.

<u>NOTE</u>: FAILURE TO EXCHANGE WRITTEN TESTIMONIAL AND DOCUMENTARY EVIDENCE BY THE DEADLINES MAY PRECLUDE A PARTY FROM PARTICIPATING AT THE EVIDENTIARY HEARING.

#### **Evidentiary Hearing Procedures**

The purpose of the Evidentiary Hearing is to establish the factual record necessary for a decision on the Project proposal. The record is developed by the presentation of sworn testimony and documentary evidence. Testimony on undisputed topics shall be submitted by sworn declarations filed under penalty of perjury and offered into evidence by stipulation of the parties.

The Applicant has the burden of presenting sufficient substantial evidence to support the findings and conclusions required for certification of the site and related facilities. [20 Cal. Code Regs. § 1748(e).]

The parties' witnesses who appear in person shall be sworn and made available for cross-examination. At the conclusion of direct testimony, the witness may be cross-examined by the parties, followed by redirect and re-cross examination as appropriate, subject to limitation by the Committee.

#### Petitions to Intervene to Become a Formal Party

The DEADLINE to file a Petition to Intervene in this case was THURSDAY, MARCH 25, 2010. Petitions filed after that date may be granted only upon a showing by the Petitioner that extraordinary circumstances made it impossible to file by the deadline, in the judgment of the Committee.

#### **Public Participation and Public Adviser**

Members of the public are welcome to attend and offer comments at the Evidentiary Hearing. It is not necessary to be an Intervenor to participate in this public process.

We encourage the public to submit comments prior to or during the Evidentiary Hearings. Comments submitted after the Evidentiary Hearings may be discussed in the Presiding Member's Proposed Decision (PMPD) or treated and discussed as comments on the PMPD, in the Committee's discretion.
