Dear Commissioner Weisenmiller:

Although you will be hearing from local representatives of the Carpenters Union, I am taking the unusual step of communicating directly with you regarding the Genesis Solar Evidentiary Hearing on July 12. I want to express our strong support for this particular project and by extension our support for the extraordinary efforts California and the California Energy Commission have been making to kick start America's transition to a renewable energy future.

One only need look to our own Gulf Coast and the continuing tragic conflicts in the Middle East to understand the necessity for abundant, environmentally clean sources of domestic energy. California's commitment to clean energy helps insure that a rapidly growing and technologically evolving domestic renewable energy industry can fulfill that critical need.

The persistent economic downturn, felt strongly in California, adds urgency to this mission. Thousands of jobs will be provided by the billions of dollars that must be invested to make this transition a reality. It could not come at a better time; for the health of our planet, the security of our nation, the economy of our state and the personal livelihood of the workers the renewable industry will need to build this future. I am expressing to you the commitment of our organization, 750, 000 members strong, to this effort.

But I offer one caveat to you as you review the issues. It is not only the technology of this emerging industry that is evolving; the construction procedures that this new industry will require are evolving as well. In order to provide cost-effective renewable energy, it is critical that the industry have the flexibility of determining the proper mix of workers needed to construct their facilities.

I urge you to be especially cautious of any labor organizations that express opposition to these urgently needed renewable energy projects on environmental grounds. While it is their right, their motives may be to pressure developers and their chosen contractors to sign outdated labor agreements that do not
