Docket 09-AFC-7, Palen Solar Power Project, Gen-Tie and Telecommunications Encroachment Concurrence 08-RIV 10, 114.402

On behalf of Solar Millennium, the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) has been asked to provide a letter of concurrence for the proposed Palen Solar Power Project (PSPP) Gen-Tie and Telecommunications fiber interconnection locations. The PSPP site is approximately 0.5 miles north of Interstate 10 (I-10) and 10 miles east of Desert Center in an unincorporated area of Riverside County. An extension of the Corn Springs Road at the I-10 Interchange will access the site.

PSPP will use an overhead single circuit 230-kilovolt line, which will cross some two miles west of the project connecting to the proposed new Southern California Edison Red Bluff substation which will be located south of I-10. The underground (HDD) communications line will cross and connect less than a mile west of the project and south of I-10.

Whereas no conflicts appear evident with the connections as shown on **Map Figure I-10 HDD Crossing** dated **May 2010**, a Caltrans encroachment permit will be required for both to ensure that the Gen-Tie and Communication lines crossing I-10 is consistent with applicable State standards as outlined in our April 23, 2010 letter.
