MOTION

I. Request for Committee Members to Attend the September 9th Workshop

On Wednesday, September 8, 2010, Calico Solar will submit a number of options to respond to the Committee's Order Directing Further Review of Reduced Footprint Alternatives. All of these options are reductions of the proposed project footprint and will result in fewer lands being developed and fewer environmental impacts. No new lands will be included in any of the options.

Calico Solar will discuss these options with the parties at the September 9, 2010 workshop noticed by the CEC staff. Calico Solar requests that one or both Committee members attend this workshop to foster a discussion of their concerns and provide initial feedback on Calico Solar's proposals. At the workshop Calico Solar would also like to discuss the option of installing temporary tortoise exclusion fencing in the event the BLM approves the project prior to the Commission's final action on the project.

II. Request for Evidentiary Hearing

Calico Solar further requests that the Committee set an evidentiary hearing for the limited purpose of receiving into the record information and testimony on the project options discussed at the September 9th workshop. Calico Solar requests that this evidentiary hearing be held early in the week of September 13, 2010. A hearing held during this week would allow Calico Solar to perform the necessary desert tortoise clearance surveys, if the project is approved, before the close of the translocation period. If no hearing date is available during the week of September 13, Calico Solar requests that the conference currently scheduled for September 20, 2010 be converted to an evidentiary hearing, but notes that such a later hearing could inhibit Calico Solar's ability to meet ARRA requirements.
