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## ISSUSES STATEMENT INTERVEOR CENTER FOR BIOLOGICAL DIVERSITY

Pursuant to the August 30, 2010, notice of a Status Conference on September 9, 2010. Intervenor Center for Biological Diversity files this Issues Statement and proposed schedule. The Committee requested "a brief discussion of what obstacles may exist which would hinder completion of this proceeding by December, 2010." The Center is unaware of any particular obstacles to completion of the proceedings by December, 2010. However, the Center is concerned that the very short timelines and rush to decision in this matter (and others) will undermine full and fair public participation. Moreover, the Center is unaware at this time of any pressing need for a decision by December, 2010. It is the Center's understanding that it is highly likely that the applicant's Blythe Solar Power Project (DOCKET NO. 09-AFC-6) will be approved at the full Commission hearing on September 15, 2010, and that the applicant intends to begin construction on the Blythe facility before the Palen facility at issue here. At this time, it is unclear whether the applicant is still seeking ARRA grant funds that depend on the December, 2010 deadline for this Palen project and whether under the current rules the applicant could obtain federal ARRA grant funds for **both** the Blythe project and this Palen project. As a result, it is unclear to the Center whether there is any need for a decision by December, 2010 in this matter.

The evidentiary issues that the Center for Biological Diversity expects to primarily focus on for testimony and cross examination are biological resources (including the adequacy of mitigation measures), soil and water, alternatives, air quality, and land use. Of these, only air quality was included Part 1 of the RSA filed by staff on September 1, 2010, and Staff has stated that the remaining issues will be included in Part 2 of the RSA which staff has indicated it expects to file on September 16, 2010. On August 30, 2010 the Center filed a motion seeking a continuance of the hearing dates from October 11 and 12, due to an unavoidable conflict and also requested that the Committee maintain reasonable deadlines for testimony, specifically, "that the parties be provided at least 2 weeks after the RSA is issued before Opening Testimony is due and an additional 2 weeks to provide Rebuttal Testimony, and that the Evidentiary Hearings should not begin until at least 4 weeks after the Rebuttal Testimony is due." In the alternative, the Center notes that Staff filed a proposed schedule on September 3, 2010, that would bifurcate the hearings along the lines of the RSA Part 1 and 2, to accommodate a federal holiday and the Center's conflict. While the Staff's proposed schedule provides very little time for the parties to prepare for hearing, it would allow the Center to participate in the evidentiary hearings for all of the issues which the Center has identified as primary areas of concern. If the Committee is inclined to adopt the Staff's proposal for bifurcated hearings, the Center requests that air quality testimony deadlines be included in the second set of testimony deadlines and the second set of evidentiary hearings.<sup>1</sup>
