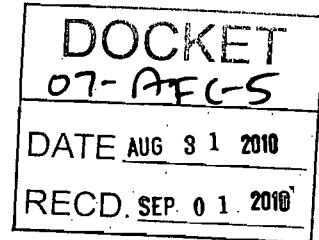


Re: IVANPAH SOLAR ELECTRIC GENERATING SYSTEM
